We, the Birzeit Women's Charitable Society are so grateful and thank you for remembering the Society. Hopefully you can support the project of health services.

In response to your letter dated January 16, 1989, O/REF.: EVDA/nm/5329.89, I would like to inform you the following:

- Birzeit Center was established in 1970 where the work was carried out very primitive. while now it is serving Bir Zeit & 23 surrounding villages' inhabitants. The same with the Outreach program. Seven satelllites were established in seven villages; ('Atara, Um Safa, 'Ajjouli, Deir-Al-Sudan, Kobar, Abushkheidem and Al-Mizer'a) and the work is carried out perfectly.
- Health Education will be continued to be given for both male and female on first aid with sessions concerning: injuries, accidents, shots, cuts, bullets, tear gaz bombs etc. in Bir Zeit and the Outreach.
- Enclosed please find the 1988 Annual Report, hoping it will be satisfactory and fulfil all your needs. Concerning the budget of USD. 134.400,00. It will be enough because the high rate of the US\$ will cover the differences. We do appreciate your generosity in such a very hard situation.

- The Dental Unit and all its equipments was donated by the Welfare Association in 1980. In 1976, the CDF paid all the Laboratory equipments and furniture. The seven satellites in the seven villages were full furnished and equipped by both the Welfare Association and Church of Sweden in 1987.
- The guarantee of the Project's continuation depends on the situation the uprising. We hope our country will be in peace, then the project itself will cover all its expenses from the inhabitants' fees.


The Project is currently carried out by:

A. An emergency lump sum of (US\$60,000.00) was sent by the Welfare association in May 1988. US\$10,000.00 was paid for medication for the Outreach program and the rest is kept for salaries.

B. Christian Aid donated (5000 Sterling Pound) in February 1988.
