Save Life - Stop the Neutron Bomb

In the name of millions and millions of women all over the world who are taking more and more resolute action, in increasing numbers, for detente, disarmament and peace, the participants in the Council Meeting, gathered in Moscow from 15 to 19 May 1978, representing 129 organizations in 118 countries, appeal to the international, regional and national women's organizations, to women all over the world to take action together to protect and safeguard life.

We note with alarm that contrary to the vital interests of humanity and legal and human standards, the forces hostile to peaceful coexistence, disarmament and peace are speeding up the arms race, promoting the development of new weapons of mass destruction, including the neutron bomb, and declaring the intention to have them stationed in Europe.

We and our peoples want our children to live and grow up in a world of peace. Today, tomorrow and always we want our children to play and laugh in nurseries and kindergartens, to fill the schools, stadiums and recreational and cultural centres, and to live without fear in their homes.

We want our young people to work, study, and see their hopes and dreams come true.

We want the creative work of man to find expression in factories and fields, in art, culture and science.

Accordingly, we forcefully condemn the policy of those military circles in the United States and other NATO countries that are threatening the world with the sinister neutron weapon, claimed to be "clean" and "humane" and conceived as a "cheap bomb" by the military-industrial corporations that propose to manufacture it, which represents an enormous leap towards the outbreak of world-wide nuclear warfare. We recoil with horror from this

prospect of extermination, the deathly silence of lifeless cities, the empty classrooms of childless schools, noiseless factories and untilled fields.

We, the participants of the WIDF Council Meeting draw the attention of all women to the world-wide movement against the neutron bomb, which found expression in the Amsterdam Appeal (of March 1978) and made US President Carter postpone his decision.

However, postponement isn't prohibition!

Therefore, we, the participants of the WIDF Council Meeting call on the women of the world to join their voices and action with ours and demand:

- that the US government renounce the manufacture of this monstrous weapon of mass extermination once and for all;
- that no government agree to its deployment on its territory;
- that all weapons of mass destruction be banned;
- that the arms race be halted and all necessary steps be taken to promote disarmament, first of all nuclear disarmament, detente and peaceful coexistence.

Together with all those who feel responsible for the fate of humanity, we can and must safeguard the future of our children and win peace.
