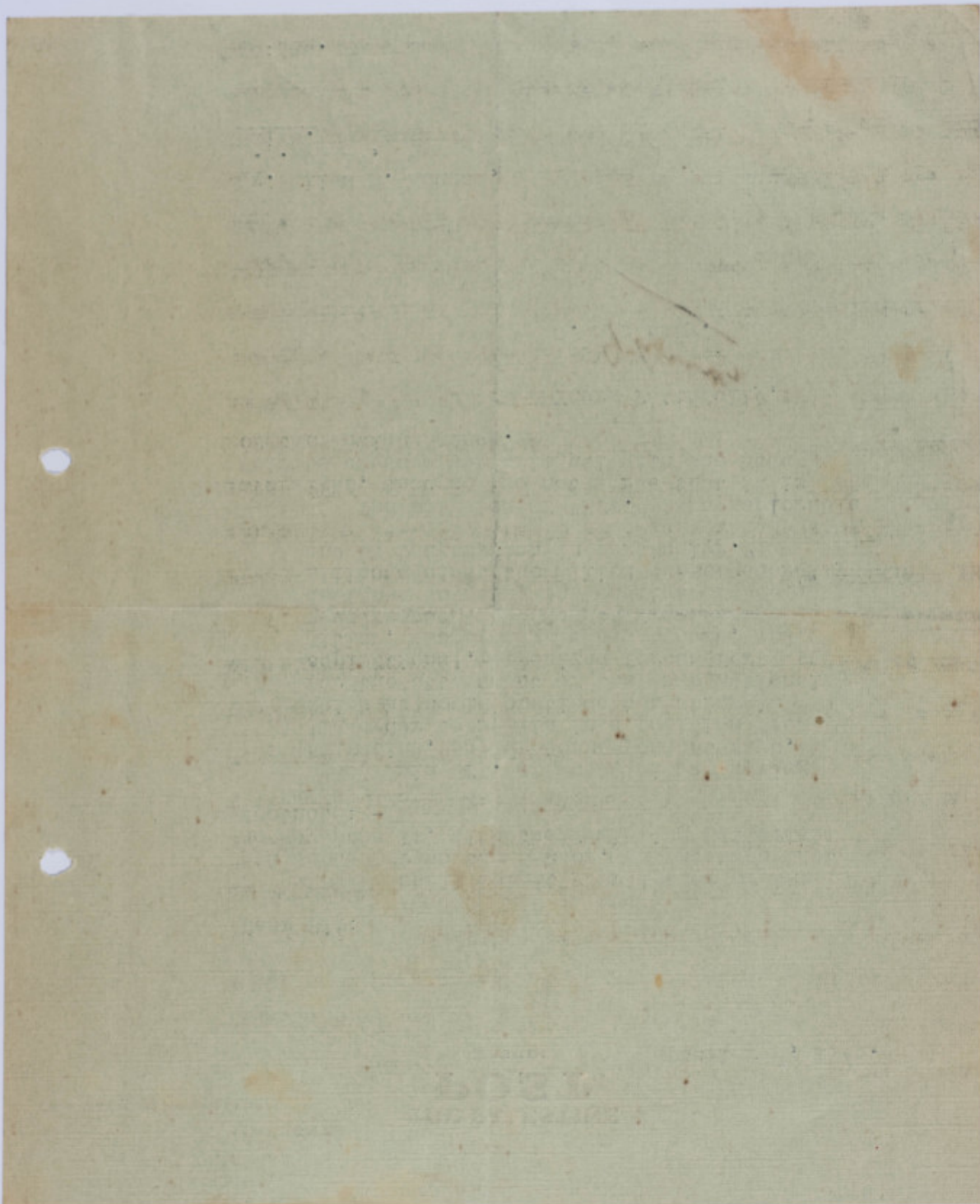

this document shows a letter addressed to Elias Koussa from G. Agronsky, who
worked with the Palestine Post, informing Koussa of the need to submit his letter
dated ٥ September ١٩٤٦ in accordance with the Censor's notes. The letter was
written as a response to a text on Haj Amin al-Husseini, which addressed al-
Husseini's role in the local struggle, his steps towards reinforcing his relation with
the Arab nation, and forming an alliance with and supporting Hitler in the face of
the Allies. Agronsky also composed the letter to apologize for omitting the
word "Effendi" in the original text and to emphasize that it was not fair to
classify al-Husseini with a war criminal such as the Head of the Jewish Agency.
