ed in English, this document features a letter from Elyas Kusa to the British Consulate-General in Haifa on 11 July 1960, regarding his previously sent letter to the Israeli Prime Minister Ben-Gurion concerning his statements delivered in the Knesset commenting on the American Senator's William Fulbright statements on the situation inside the Middle East.
