

A Paper Clipping Documenting the Address of the Liberation News Service, California, U.S.A

Typed in English, this paper clipping documents the address of Liberation News Service in California, U.S.A. The news service was founded in 1968 by Marshall Bloom and Raymond Mungo after they were dismissed from the United States Students Press Association for their radical tendencies. Their newspaper was issued biweekly in Washington, then it was moved to New York. It is unclear if the clipping is taken from a letter or is a documentary clipping for research purposes.
