## **A Letter from the Officers at the Arab Development Society to Barclays Bank, 6 July 1977**

Sent on 6 July 1977, this document shows a letter from the officers at the Arab Development Society to Barclays Bank.

From the Officers of the Arab Development Society.

July 6th, 1977.

To the Manager, Barclays Bank, Easton Road Branch.

Dear Sir,

As the result of a meeting with Musa Alami in London yesterday, we have had his instructions to:

1. Close the deposit a/c no 50117021, after payment into it of a cheque for £5,00 from Miss A Renier. And to transfer the whole sum in that account to Aaman (address as below).
2. Also to transfer the sum of £3270 from the deposit account to the same Aaman address.
3. We would therefore ask you to obtain the consent of the Bank of England to the transfer to Aaman of:

£8647.32, deducting therefore any charges that may be entailed, and requesting the Arab Bank, Aaman, to place it to the credit of Musa Faidy al Alami, The Arab Development Society (Sterling current account).

4. We also enclose, for you to see, the original of the new deed having reference to the deposit account, and will forward to you tomorrow the third signature that you will require in order to release the current a/c balance. We are leaving a photostat copy of this deed with you. It is still missing the signature of one trustee, Dr Amin Majjanj, who is in Israel, but this will be obtained as soon as a safe hand can be found to carry the document there.
