FINAL REMINDER.

Sir

I have to direct your attention to the fact that the sum of L.P. 1.225 Mils due in respect of telephone service, payment of which was requested in the account dated 11 Jan. 1935, has not yet been received.

I have, therefore, to inform you that unless payment is received within seven days of the date of this letter, your telephone will be disconnected from the Exchange and will only be re-connected on payment of the outstanding amount, plus 250 mils re-connection fee.

If payment is not received within fourteen days of the date of this letter, the telephone will be removed from your premises and will only be re-installed on payment of a further installation fee (minimum L.P. 4).
