This Certificate of Registration is issued subject to the provision of (A) Article 3 of The Law of Disposition of Immovable Property of 5th Jumaad-ul-Awwal 1331 (30th March 1929) and (B) Article 9 of the Transfer of Land Ordinance 1920.

The provisions are:

(A) "Formal title deeds are valid and executory. The Civil and Sharia Courts shall give judgment on these deeds and their registration without further proof. A formal title deed shall not be annulled except by a judgment of a Court based on lawful reasons."

(B) "No guarantee of title or of the validity of the transaction is implied by the consent of the Administration and the registration of the Deed".
