Re : Medical Insurance

I should herewith like to inform you that the hotel pays, BY LAW, on top of the salary of each employee holding a Jerusalem Identity Card ca 2 1/2% as premium for the Medical Insurance, (Kupat Holim).

The 2 1/2% represent approximately represents two thirds of the total amount each person has to pay, in order to be fully insured against all doctor expenses, stays in hospitals, medicine etc.

The insurance is however VOID if the employee as an individual omits to pay his share of one third.

I strongly suggest that every-body joins Kupat Holim. The amount due would be deducted directly by the Personnel Department, which would also take care of the necessary formes and papers.

It should be clearly understood that the hotel at present pays a large sum of money for this purpose, which is lost and waisted only due to lack of interest and wrong opportunisme from part of the staff.

The hotel will therefore in no case pay any indemnity for any kind of medical expenses to Jerusalem ID card holders and will ask for a written statement in this regard from each employee who has not joined Kupat Holim by the end of this month.

For employees holding West Bank papers, the case is at present studies and will be referred to within the next few days.
